Post-Installation Checklist

Components: The installation includes the track system, wall jambs, basic panels, and a telescopic panel. Optionally, door panels or a communication panel may be integrated as part of the wall system.

Handling Tool: A detachable handle is provided for the locking and unlocking mechanism of the panels. The operation hole is located on the edge of basic panels and the face of the telescopic panel for easy access.

Panel Operation and Handling

Single Point Panels: These panels are centrally hung. Extra caution is required when moving them to prevent any damage to the ceiling or floor coverings. When maneuvering these panels, ensure movements are gentle and calculated.

Two Point Suspension Panels

Handling: Remove panels from the storage area individually. When navigating through track junctions, it's advisable to hold the panel with both hands at shoulder height for better control. In straight track sections, panels may be moved with one hand, but ensure stability and control at all times.

Maintenance and Care

Regular Checks: Periodically inspect the track, panel alignment, and locking mechanisms to ensure smooth operation and to prevent any potential damage.

Cleaning: Keep the track and panels free from dust and debris. Use a soft, dry cloth for cleaning surfaces to maintain the appearance and functionality of the wall.

Professional Maintenance: For any repairs or adjustments, consult with a professional service provider to ensure the integrity and safety of the wall system.
